

Friends of Camp Geiger Regulations

1. AGE

16 years of age to handle a weapon

14 years to be a musician

2. Footwear MUST be period- NO SNEAKERS **special needs need prior approval

3. Eyewear must be correct or as close to be correct, you may also wear contacts.

4. Canteens are MANDATORY- They must also be filled before taking the field.

5. No anachronisms on the person! Including but not limited to: wristwatches, earrings, jewelry (wedding rings only), cigarettes, lighters bandanas, ECT.

6. Ramrods are permitted but not drawn.

7. Bayonets not fixed on the scabbards must have tips unbroken on the field belt.

8. No weapons are to be discharged within 25 yards.

9. No LIVE Ammunition at the reenactment for any reason. No tampions beyond the point of departure to battlefield.

10. No taking of flags, unless discussed ahead of time.

11. Fouled muskets are to be taken a minimum of 29 paces behind the line, under the supervision of sgt/armorer to clear only. The sgt/armorer is the only one allowed to draw the rammer. If it can not be cleared, you must then take a hit.

12. Non-authentic visitors are encouraged to dress authentically, otherwise are expected to depart at the end of the day and not return until the next day.

13. No visible anachronisms in the camp at any time; this includes but not limited to: coolers, cans/bottles, 20th century clothing (t-shirts, sneakers, ECT), sleeping bags, and rail road lanterns. Camps will be inspected.

14. Rank- Officers are expected to bring troops or have been assigned to an appropriate staff position.

15. Uniforms must be 19th century cut and tailoring, correct cloth is necessary.

16. No drunken or boisterous behavior will be tolerated. Quiet hours are from midnight to 6AM.

17. Straw will be available at registration for a fee to sleep on and seal bottoms of tents.

18. Firewood will be available. Take only what you need, when you need it. There will be no bonfires. Wood is to be used generously.

19. Registration is open Friday at noon until 9PM and will reopen Saturday at 6AM-9AM.

20. No cars in camp after 9AM Saturday and Sunday after 3PM! NO EXECPTIONS!

21. You must be in period attire to receive your meal on Saturday night. "NO DRESS, NO FOOD"

22. If you are in period attire you must register and pay any fees that are required.

23. All children must be attended too. They can not be left alone for anytime period without adult supervision.

24. The water is for drinking and eating, it is not for bathing at the tanks and doing dirty dishes. You may take it back to camp and use it at your disposal.

If you have any problems or questions, please bring them to your NCO or officers. Our goal is to insure that it is a positive experience.
