



Civilian Authenticity Standards:

Please note that authenticity guidelines will be enforced for all participants. Participants who do not abide by these rules will be asked to correct the incorrect in question. This applies to civilians in the civilian camp and the civilians. If at anytime you have a question regarding the authenticity guidelines please contact the civilian coordinator. Event staff has final ruling in all discrepancies.

All modern items must be out of site at all times. Children must be appropriately outfitted for their age. Do research period hairstyles and practices before the event. You must be in period dress from the start of the event to the finish.

Please let it be noted that there is NO place for the following at this event:

- * Snoods (this is a modern term) Crocheted, ribbon or decorative hairnet or day caps are appropriate for the time period and this event.
- * NO Ball or evening gowns; day, traveling or visiting dresses are acceptable attire
- * White blouses/ skirt combinations are discouraged for those over 20 years of age.
- * Nail polish/obvious makeup
- * Sneakers/tennis shoe/flip flops/ hiking boots/flats/loafers
- * MODERN HAIRSTYLES (including bangs and ponytails)
- * Sunglasses- Period eyeglasses are encouraged
- * Modern toys outside of your tent (we understand children often have that one thing they can't live without)
- * Modern Jewelry- wrist watches, body piercing other than earrings
- *Rings are allowed but only wedding/engagement rings; only one other ring on the hand is allowed on the ring finger if it is of period.
- * No lady is to lift her dress no more than 2 inches off the ground in public; if you must, please find somewhere out of the public eye.
- * Ladies are not to disrupt or bother the infantryman while the unit is under formation. This rule will be strictly enforced.
- *Every lady should act like a lady from the 1860's while in public.
- *Undergarments including ruffles of the hoop should not show beyond edge of skirt.
